Degree Program	Degree programs regularly have special/unique: <ul> <li>Admissions</li> <li>Content/curriculum</li> <li>Diploma</li> </ul> <li>50% difference in curriculum/courses between degree programs</li> <li>Impact on transcript:         <ul> <li>Degree noted on transcript</li> </ul> </li> <li>Impact on diploma:         <ul> <li>Degree noted on diploma</li> </ul> </li>
Concentration	Curriculum/content must have at least 20% difference in curriculum/courses between other programs in these areas:  • Courses, practicum, and/or research  Must have enough qualified faculty (according to professional accreditation standards) to teach/guide a concentration  Must have appropriate clinical practice sites, if applicable  Impact on transcript:  • Concentration may be noted on transcript depending on program's needs  Impact on diploma:  • Concentration may be noted on diploma depending on program's needs
Specialization	Adds to the concentration

Impact on transcript:

• Specialization *not* noted on transcript

Impact on diploma:

• Specialization *not*
